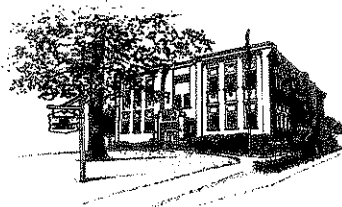

The Science Connecticut Mastery Test (CMT) will be given from March 9 to March 20. It is important that students in Grades 5 and 8 are prepared to perform to their highest level of academic ability for this assessment.

The Connecticut Mastery Test measures how well students perform against state standards in Science. Our schools have worked hard in preparing students to do well on these assessments by teaching them the essential skills and concepts. Parents and guardians also play an important role by encouraging their children to do their best, be well rested, eat breakfast in the morning, and arrive at school on time.

The results of the Mastery test are scored by the state. Student scores will be sent to the district in early fall of the next school year. The district will share this information with families as soon as it becomes available.
